RULES

1. **Submit entry request before 11AM on Friday, June 29th**; entry fee (if required) must be paid at the time entry form is received. You can bring your entry form to: Oak Valley Community Bank at 191 W. North Street before the cut-off time.
2. All units must be in line at 9:00 AM, parade starts at 10:00 AM sharp.
3. Thirty feet spacing is required between all units. Entries cannot be over 12 feet high from the ground.
4. All entries must complete parade route or be disqualified.
5. **No** throwing of objects is allowed, this includes candy.
6. All float entries must be constructed of flame retardant materials. Fire extinguishers are required on all floats.
7. All bicycle riders must wear helmets.
8. All Parade Marshalls and Officials must be obeyed.
9. All entries are subject to review by the Parade Committee and may be disqualified if deemed unsafe or in poor taste.
10. An entry cannot participate in more than one category and will be judged in that category only.
11. The judging stand will be on the left side of the parade route.
12. Parade judging for horses starts at 8:30 AM.
13. Equestrian entries judged by the California State Horseman's Association (C.S.H.A.).
14. Equestrian entries, please clean up after horse at staging and end of parade (pooper scoopers provided in parade route).
15. Riding the parade route before line up is not allowed.
16. 60 seconds in the allowable time for performing before the Judging/Announcing Stand: **Equestrian units** are limited to one complete circle.
17. Control of vehicles and animals must be maintained at all times.
18. No one under the eight (8) years of age may appear as an entry unless accompanied by an adult.
19. Units with unusual or loud noise must inform parade Chairman before the parade. Failure to do so could result in disqualification and could frighten the horses.
20. All participants agree to release the Manteca Independence Day Celebration, City of Manteca, members and workers of the Parade Committee, Committee designates, and all responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any person or property from participation in this event. All participants must respect the right of all property owners. Remember, we are guests in their neighborhood.
