Guidelines to Qualify

The Manteca Sunrise Kiwanis will award scholarships to two graduating seniors from each local high school (Calla, East Union, Manteca & Sierra). The amount will be \$2,000 per student, as long as the following criteria is met.

Late applications will not be considered.

- Submission of applications will be the responsibility of the counseling staff of each school, with the Kiwanis Scholarship Committee making the final selection. Recipients may or may not be announced prior to the awards ceremony.

Applications must be submitted to your school counseling office by the April deadline given for the year in which you are applying Check with your counselor for the deadline.

- The application and both essay questions must be completed in order to qualify. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- A current copy of your transcript must be included.
- No minimum grade point average is required.
- Only one scholarship entry per student. Applications must be typed and signed.
- Two letters of reference are required. You may attach additional documents if desired (support letters, etc.).
- 3. The current President of Sunrise Kiwanis or designee will present the scholarships at the scholarship ceremony.

Payment of Scholarship will be as follows:

- 4. Each request for scholarship funds must be in writing from the student. Verification from the school with the embossed school seal showing that student is enrolled in at least 12 units, is required. Verification from the student will not be considered. Once verification is received from the school, a check will be sent to the financial aid office in the student's name. allow three weeks for delivery. In the case a student receives a full scholarship from the school of choice, the funds from this scholarship can be used for additional educational needs such as housing/moving expenses, technology needs, etc. This will be on a reimbursement basis once receipts are received by Kiwanis at the address above. Students shall seek approval before expending funds for reimbursement.
- 5. The scholarship will be paid in one payment. Each student has a maximum of two years from the date of graduation from high school to be eligible to receive the amount awarded. No extensions will be allowed.
- 6. Each selected student must attend a Sunrise Kiwanis meeting to be introduced to the membership, we ask each student to give a brief talk on their plans, goals, and choice of study.

Our intent is not to place obstacles in the path of the recipients; however, we must be cautious and responsible when scholarship funds are at stake.
